1. **Bagmati Municipality, Office of Municipal Executive** invites sealed bids or electronic bids from Nepalese eligible bidders for the construction of **Road Construction Works North of Basumaya Ale's House** under National Competitive Bidding procedures. The estimated amount for the works is Rs. **70,60,845.10 [inclusive VAT]**.

4. Pre-bid meeting shall be held at **Bagmati Municipality, Office of Municipal Executive, Karmaiya, Sarlahi** at 2026/05/22.
5. Bids must be submitted to the office **Bagmati Municipality, Office of Municipal Executive, Karmaiya, Sarlahi** through PPMO website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp before 12:00 on 2026/06/02. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 13:00 on 2026/06/02 at the office of **Bagmati Municipality, Office of Municipal Executive, Karmaiya, Sarlahi**. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the bid submission deadline and must be accompanied by scanned copy of the bid security in .pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRS 1,65,000, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
